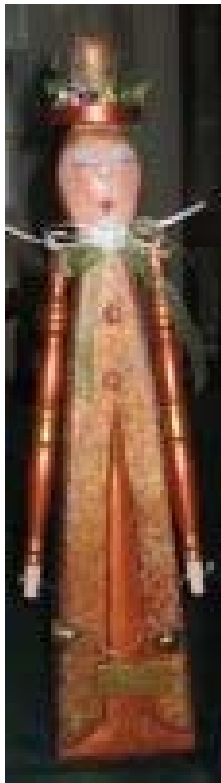

**Crisis Center:** **Georgia Wanda & Pat Brown** Georgia thanked everyone for all the generosity of goods and canvas painted bags.

**Vintage Books:** **Dorothy Mestan** Dorothy thanked everyone for their donations and purchases. The hardcover books are \$1.00, others are \$ .10 and \$ .25 each.

**Ways and Means:** **Sandy Dreher, Alberta Overocker, Irene Schranz** There are banner hangers for sale for \$2.50 each. Brushes for sales from Scharff Brushes, SSB received part of the sales. Tote bags for \$8.00, a number of pockets for painting supplies.

**Sunshine:** **Ronni Benedetti** Ronni reported she send out emails announcing the March and April birthdays for our members. Rita Bartak, has a new grandson, who needs our prayers. Sandy Dreher has a new home in Tinley Park.

**Historian:** **Nancy Carley** We need a volunteer to help takeover the scrapbook for SSB.

**Raffle:** **Susan Hanek** SSB made \$190.00 profit on the bag, painting supply raffle and \$161.00 on the regular raffle. Total amount that Susan made that day on raffles was \$351.00. Susan thanked Cheri Putz and Pam Carley for the many hand painted items they donated.

**Old Business:** The purchase of the projector that we would be approximately \$2,000. The reason for the high cost is because you need a projector with high lumens to be able to see in a room with lights on. Barbara Urban suggested because of the high cost we should wait until we have more money before making a purchase. At that time, we can get an estimate for the projector and then apply for a scholarship grant from SDP.

**New Business:** The Board had voted to ask the members to pay a \$10 fee for the paint-in classes at our September membership meeting. The reason was that the expenses were getting to be too high for the club to absorb the paint-in cost at that meeting. The \$10.00 would include all classes for that day. The class fee for the guests would still be no charge. Members and guest would be expected to pay for their lunches.

SSB liaison to SDP is Cheri Putz.

**Service Project:** Joan Muzzey was approached by the Crisis Center asking if SSB would be able to volunteer some time to teaching the children, at the Center. We discussed teaching the children one Saturday a month, for two hours, 1 – 3 pm. The dates available are April 9, May 14 and June 11. There are approximately 20 children, ages 6 and younger. It was decided to keep the project to a minimum and the club would contribute toward the expenses, because this is a philanthropic project. Joan was taking items from the art supply/bag sale to be used for materials for future classes. The teachers would bring basic supplies along when possible. This would then be our second Philanthropic project for 2011.

**Group Painting for the Crisis Center:** A Saturday in June or July will be scheduled for members to join together at the Palos Park District to paint canvas bags for the Crisis Center. The cost to the Chapter to rent the room with is \$18/hour, a total of 3 hours. The Palos Heights Park District is on 127<sup>th</sup> just west of Ridgeland. We will check with the Paark District for the date and then notify the members. Georgia Wanda asked for a show of hands to see how many people would be interested. There was a good response.

Board Meeting is April 5, 2011 at the Worth Public Library, 6817 W. 111<sup>th</sup> Street, Worth, Illinois, 6:30 pm.

Our **MAY PAINT-IN** will feature, for the very first time at South Side Brushes, one of our fellow members, Gloria Boggs. Gloria will be teaching her own Floral Design in Watercolors. The cost of the Paint-In is \$10.00. The Surface for this class is \$1.50. There is also a Palette Fee of \$3.00. For the total cost of \$14.50, each student will receive an 8 x 10 100 lb. Heavyweight Cold Press Illustration Board and a Watercolor Palette. 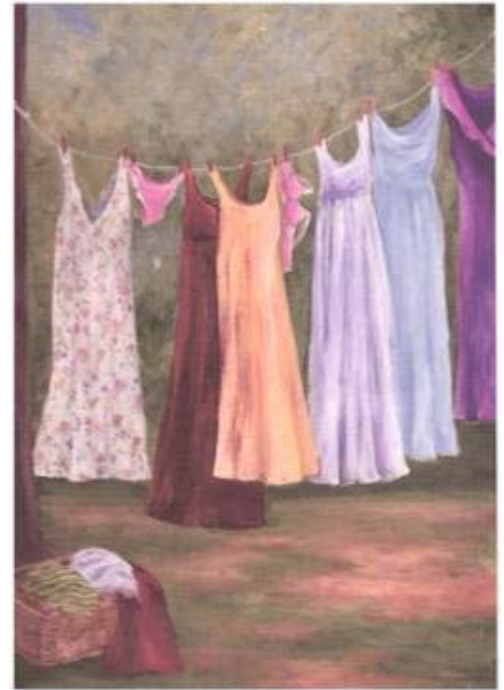

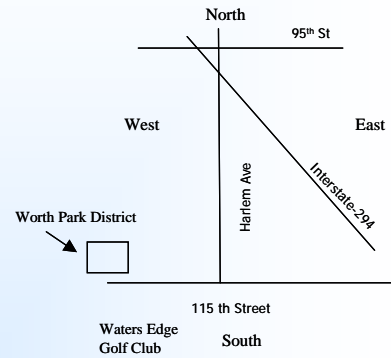
