## PAINT-IN

Our **MARCH PAINT-IN** will feature one of our favorite local teachers (and fellow South Side Brush member), Sandy Dreher. Sandy will be teaching Patricia Rawlinson's Summer Geranium Banner. The cost of the Paint-In is \$10.00. The Pattern and Surface Fee for this class is \$12.00. For the total cost of \$22.00, each student will receive Patricia Rawlinson's Pattern Packet, a Roc Lon Banner and a Varnishing Sponge.

For an additional \$7.00, South Side Brushes' Hospitality Committee is offering an optional catered lunch. Please see Pam's article for more information.

You may sign up for Sandy's March Paint-In, Summer Geranium Banner by contacting me via phone or e-mail, or by filling out the coupon on the last page of this Newsletter and returning it to me, along with your check in the amount of \$22.00 (or \$29.00 if you would also like to order the optional catered lunch) made payable to South Side Brushes.

**NOTE:** The Preparation Instructions for this Project ask you to trace the pattern with white tracing paper. Since you will not be receiving the pattern until the date of the class, you may trace the pattern in class that day. However, it is very **important** that, **prior to the date of the class**, you use a foam roller to roll **two (2) coats of Lamp Black to each side of the Banner**, as it will be easier to trace the design when your basecoat has had ample time to dry. The paints used for this project are Deco Art Americana Colors, as follows:

Black Green	Lamp Black
Bleached Sand	Napa Red
Blue Violet	Naphthol Red
Blush Flesh	Burnt Umber
Country Blue	Milk Chocolate
Evergreen	Hauser Dark Green
Olive Green	Hauser Medium Green
Soft Black	Hauser Light Green
Soft Lilac	Traditional Burnt Sienna

The brushes recommended for this project are Royal Brushes, as follows:

Large Crescent Stencil Brush  
 #8, #12 Royal Fusion Shader  
 1/2" Oval Wash  
 #1 Liner, 10/0 Liner  
 #8 Majestic Filbert  
 Sea Sponge



If you would like to order the paint for this project, our Ways and Means Committee will be happy to obtain it for you. Please contact Sandy at (815) 528-8158, prior to the deadline date for ordering paints, February 25, 2011, and she will deliver it to you on the date of the class, March 19, 2011.

## MAY PAINT-IN

Our **MAY PAINT-IN** will feature another one of our members, Gloria Bogs. Gloria took her very first painting class in oils at Lee Wards some 35 years ago. She also studied painting with Jane Drynan at her Beverly Studio, as well as portraiture at Gladco Arts. Before experiencing painting, Gloria was a high school physical education and math teacher. She then combined her love of teaching and her love for painting together, beginning a 30-year career teaching painting where her love with the brush began, at Lee Wards, Jane's Studio and Gladco Arts. Today she teaches oils, pastels, watercolors and acrylics in her home studio. Gloria is a very accomplished artist and has been commissioned to paint numerous murals. Gloria is married and has one son. She walks 4-1/2 miles every day with her two German Shepherds, Storm and Fury (named for the bowling balls).



For our May Paint-In, Gloria will be teaching her own Floral Design in Watercolors. The cost of the Paint-In is \$10.00. The Surface for this class is \$1.50. There is also a Palette Fee of \$3.00. For the total cost of \$14.50, each student will receive an 8 x 10 100 lb. Heavyweight Cold Press Illustration Board and a Watercolor Palette. If you wish to eliminate the Surface Fee and/or the Palette Fee, you may bring your own surface and/or your own watercolor paints as follows:

Alizarine Crimson  
Cadmium Yellow  
Payne's Grey  
Purple

Raw Sienna  
Sap Green  
Ultramarine Blue

Gloria also recommends a #5 Round and 1/2" Flat Watercolor Brushes for this Project.

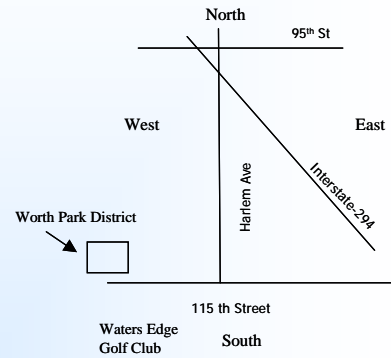
